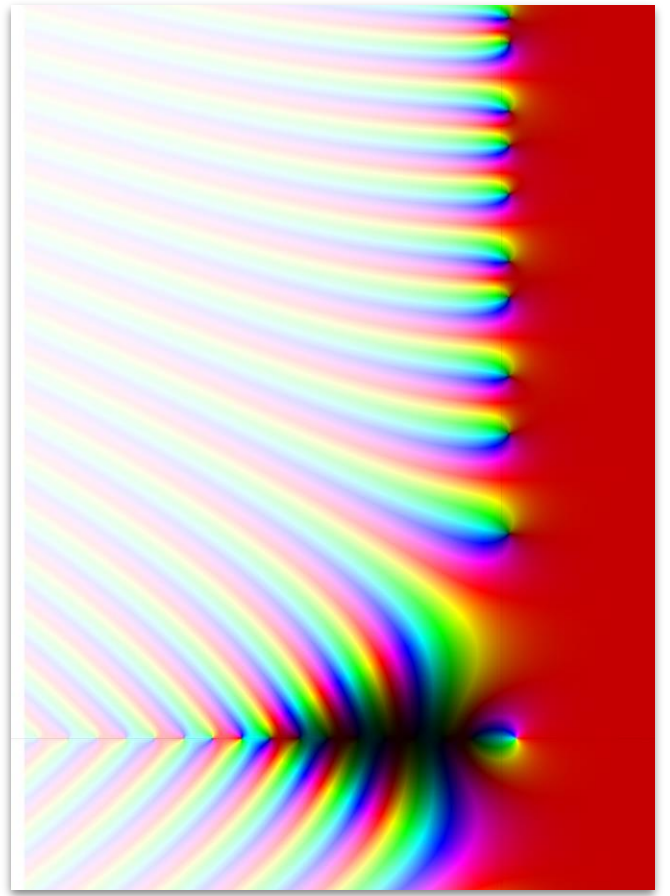


# Accelerated Degree Program
